Home Buyer Tax Credit at a Glance

- A first time home buyer is someone that has not owned a principle residence in the three years prior to the purchase.
- A move up / repeat home buyer is someone who has owned and lived in their previous home for five consecutive years out of the last eight years.
- The tax credit does not have to be repaid unless the home is sold or ceases to be used as the buyer's principle residence within three years after the purchase
- The tax credit is equal to 10% of the home's purchase price up to \$8,000 for first time home buyers and \$6,500 for move up / repeat home buyers
- The tax credit applies to homes \$800,000 or less
- The tax credit applies to homes purchased on or before April 30, 2010. However, in cases where a binding sales contract is signed by April 30, 2010, the home purchase qualifies provided it is completed by June 30, 2010.
- Single taxpayers with incomes up to \$125,000 and married couples with combined incomes up to \$225,000 qualify for the full tax credit.
